Spanish and Belgian company will open in Panamá the biggest factory of wind turbine generator in Latin America.

The company that is a member of the consortium composed of Spanish and Belgium capital. **Holly World Computers** (Spanish) has the 40 per cent and **Turbowinds** has 40 per cent of the total capital.

The prince of Belgium, Philippe, was a mere observer of this agreement. He was visiting Panamá because he was in a governmental business Belgian mission. After the sign of both companies, he made a speech. He emphasized that Panamá is a country that it is hammer in the economy of the world and he stressed its economic achieve.

Turbowinds, old American WindMaster, is a Belgian company with 30 years in the market. It has factories of wind turbine generators in Belgium, Ukraine and India.

Maxo Benalal, executive director of Panamanian Technological Industry (PTI) said that this factory will be the biggest one in Latin America and the first to installer a production of wind towers.

The company will be in [Economic Special Area of Panamá Pacific](#). The inversion of the project is about 10 million of dollars. It will star to work in August of the next year. PTI will have about fifty workers the first year to pay attention in the running of wind generators.
